CALLING FUTURE URBAN THINKERS WHO ARE CURIOUS AND INTERESTED IN HOW WE CAN REVITALISE POST-INDUSTRIAL CITIES

A research-led curriculum on contemporary challenges posed in industrial heritage settings. Understand the post-industrial city as a complex system characterised by physical, political, and historical development paths, limits, and dynamic social, economic, ecological, and cultural vectors.

1st semester Core Courses and City Lab (Germany)

Learn the essential tools to understand the study of the post-industrial city and join a one week "CityLab" at University College Cork in Ireland

2nd semester - Thematic track options (any of 4 countries)

Choose one of four thematic specialisation tracks jointly delivered by two universities.

- Track 1 Urban Transformations and Resilience (Cork, Ireland)
- Track 2 Diversity and Social Justice (Istanbul, Turkey)
- Track 3 Urban Analysis: Smart, Sustainable and Resilient Cities (Bochum, Germany)
- Track 4 Governance of Post-Industrial Cities (Zagreb, Croatia)

3rd semester - In-depth studies, practical training or research (Ireland or Belgium)

Choose between in-depth studies and practical training or research at either University College Cork (Ireland) or University of Liège (Belgium).

4th semester - Dissertation (any of 8 countries!)

Choose among a traditional dissertation (jointly supervised by two of the universities), a research manuscript aiming at publication, or a practical project accompanied by documentation
